Kang Chiao International School - Linkou Campus (KCIS-LK) is a private, co-educational, non-profit school with boarding facilities. Established in 2018, KCIS-LK offers an International Program for Grades 7-12.

Accreditation and Curriculum

KCIS-LK is accredited by the Ministry of Education (MOE) of the Republic of China (Taiwan). We offer a curriculum that allows students to explore aspects of their own individuality and their relationship with the world in the context of a rigorous academic college preparatory program.

The academic curriculum is based on American Curriculum with Honors and Advanced Placement (AP) courses, and the regular program is based on the Common Core and requirements from the MOE of the Republic of China (Taiwan). In order to receive a high school graduation diploma, students must have successfully earned 150 credits over the course of three years.

Kang Chiao Featured Activities

Kang Chiao International School is committed to cultivating students' determination, endurance and mindset for challenges. All students are required to participate in the following featured activities before graduation*:

- G8 Hiking at HeHuan Mountain (4-day hike)
- G9 Swimming across Sun Moon Lake (3.3 km swim)
- G10 Cycling Around Taiwan (12-day ride for 1000 km)

Course Offering and Weighting, and Grade Distribution

The KCIS-LK International Program Curriculum is based on American Curriculum with Honors and Advanced Placement (AP) courses, and the regular program is based on the Common Core and requirements from the Ministry of Education (MOE) of the Republic of China (Taiwan).

Students of the International Program normally take more than 200 credits before high school graduation, including:

- 60 credits of English
- 30 credits of Math
- 20 credits of Science
- 20 credits of Social Studies
- 24 credits of World Literature
- 24 credits of PE/Health and Swimming
- 12 credits of Visual and Performing Arts
- 8 credits of Second Language
- 8 credits of Other Required Electives

To cater for the individualized educational needs of students, and to encourage them to challenge themselves academically, up to 30 Honors and Advanced Placement (AP) courses are offered.

The scale below indicates how the letter grades and course scores are converted into the calculation of Weighted Grade Points Average (GPA).
